#### New Pay Rate Guides Available 3.75% Increase

The new pay rates which take up the 3.75% wage increase are now available. <u>See here</u> to download your required award information.

#### Energy Bill Relief for Small Businesses in Victoria

With the extension of the Australian Government's Energy Bill Relief Fund, eligible small businesses will receive a rebate to be paid in instalments on their electricity bill throughout 2024-25. If your small business has an annual electricity consumption of under 40 MWh, you will automatically receive your energy bill rebate. <u>See here for more details.</u>

# In Other Bookkeeping\_BAS News...

**Tax Tables Changing:** The tax tables are changing on 1 July 2024 - make sure your software is up to date!

**Super to increase 1 July 2024:** The super rate will increase to 11.5% on 1 July 2024. This will apply to the first pay run dated after 1 July 2024.

**STP Finalisation:** Employers - reminder that you must finalise your FY24 payroll by 14th July 2024.

<u>Can I Claim the GST on That</u> page updated: Some new items have been added to this list including whether GST applies when you pay for goods using digital currency and GST on compression socks.

**Changes to Retail Award from 14 May 2024**: Find out how an employee's pay is calculated when they're not given at least 12 hours break between shifts under the <u>Retail Award</u>.

**Next BAS due date:** The next quarterly BAS for **April to June 2024**, is due by **28th July 2024** if electing to receive and lodge by paper and not an active STP reporter. If,

however, you have elected to receive and lodge electronically, this BAS is due by **26th** August **2024**.

**Next IAS due date:** The June 2024 Instalment Activity Statement is due by **21st July 2024**.

Next Super due date: The Q4 2023-24 SG is due by 28th July 2024.
