For payroll, which 2023 Easter days are public holidays in your state?



It's officially the start of Easter week in Australia. Easter holidays begin this Friday, 7th April, and end Tuesday 11th April. If you are responsible for processing payroll for your staff or client, you will need to know which of these days are public holidays in your state, to ensure your payroll is correct. To assist you, I am providing the public holidays for each state this year. See below:

Year	Date	Day	Holiday	States
2023	7 Apr	Fri	Good Friday	National
	8 Apr	Sat	Day following Good Friday	National except TAS & WA
	9 Apr	Sun	Easter Sunday	National except NT, SA & TAS
	10 Apr	Mon	Easter Monday	National
	11 Apr	Tue	Easter Tuesday *	TAS
