How the National Day of Mourning for Her Majesty The Queen will affect your payroll



With the passing of her Majesty Queen Elizabeth II, <u>it has been decided</u> that there will be a National Day of Mourning on Thursday, 22nd September 2022 in Australia. This day will be a public holiday for payroll purposes and normal <u>public</u> <u>holiday rules and entitlements</u> apply. This means you must treat this day as you

would any other public holiday when it comes to paying your staff. For specific details for your state, including trading rules, visit the following links:
