Important Dates for your Business (and a couple of other things you should know!)



This week's newsletter is all about some important dates that are coming up for your business that you should be across. There are also 2 other things you might be interested in at the end...

Important Dates

The following dates are coming up very soon and may impact your business. Please read on to see if any of these items affect you:

- Did you miss the deadline to pay your employees' super which was 28th July 2022? If so, you must (or your tax/BAS agent) lodge a Super Guarantee Charge Statement by 29th August 2022. See more information <u>here</u>.
- Fuel Tax Credits have changed again. The change occurred on 1st August 2022. Make sure you are reporting the correct rates on your BAS. See this <u>ATO webpage</u> for more information.

- Pandemic Leave Disaster Payment this initiative has been extended until 30th September 2022. If you or your employee needs to access this payment, go to <u>this webpage</u> to apply.
- 4. EMDG due date is 17th August 2022. EMDG stands for <u>Export Market</u> <u>Development Grant</u>. If your business is eligible to apply for this grant, you had better hurry as it ends this Wednesday!

A Couple of Other Things

To finish with, I'd like to share that the ATO has recommenced offsetting your tax refunds or credits to pay off any of your current tax debts. The ATO had stopped this activity during the pandemic but now that it's over (well, that's debatable!), they are back to clawing back your dollars. Something to be aware of!
