# Useful Links for NSW & QLD Flood Disaster Victims



Sadly, over the past few weeks, we have seen great devastation across NSW and QLD due to a major flood disaster. Many have lost lives, homes and livelihoods. While most will be just trying to get through each day, those who are business owners now have the added pressure of dealing with insurance claims, employees, lost data and ongoing ATO deadlines.

This newsletter aims to provide some useful links to those affected by the flood crisis, especially business owners. We hope you find these links helpful.

#### ATO Assistance

The ATO doesn't want flood victims to worry about tax issues right now (and rightly so!). Firstly, those who have activity statements due on 28th Feb 2022 or 21 March

2022, have been granted an extension to 28th March 2022. If it is not possible to meet this date, then the ATO would like to be contacted in order to put a deferral in place. Further assistance is outlined on the <u>ATO's website here</u>. For those who have lost their tax records in the floods, here is some information from the ATO <u>about the way forward</u>.

### Dealing with Employees
